What You Can Do to Stop Petty Crime

To All Residents

As you may be aware Harbourside Park Towers has 24 hour security. Unfortunately, it is not practical for our staff to watch every area of the building all of the time. Too often theft occurs that, in most cases, could have been prevented if the resident had taken some simple precautions.

*Time is the enemy of thieves. Anything that delays their actions reduces the likelihood of a theft. **Don't make it easy for them!** Here are a few simple precautions that every resident can take to protect their belongings.*

Automobiles

Please do not leave valuables visible in an unlocked car in the parkade. Instead lock valuables out of sight in your trunk.

In the past, residents have lost money that has been left in plain view on the seat of their unlocked vehicle in the parkade.

Don't make it easy for them!

Valuables

Please do not store valuable items in your storage locker. Instead, put valuable items in your in-suite storage area. Items stowed in your storage locker should be in unmarked boxes (moving boxes are ideal) or covered in such a way as to disguise what is stored in your locker. Secure your locker with a good quality lock.

Every year residents lose VCR's or TV's from their storage lockers that could have been stowed safely in their in-suite storage area.

Don't make it easy for them!

Bicycles

Bicycle storage lockers are provided for most units. Bicycle lockers are of the same construction (wire mesh) as the storage lockers but are smaller in size. Please store your bicycle in your bicycle storage locker and secure it with a good lock.

If you don't have a bicycle storage locker, bicycle racks are available on a first come first served basis. Please choose a bicycle rack behind the second parking gate in the resident parking area for better security.
